The Control of Dogs Order 1992 provides that dogs must wear a collar and tag giving the name and address of the owner when in a public place.

In most cases, it is expected that this will enable the owner to be identified with relative ease.

Failure to comply with this direction is an offence under *Animal Health Act 1981* and such dogs may be seized, even if a person is in charge of such a dog.
